



TOURNEY BRIEF: 2019 Bay of Quinte Multi-species

Hosted in the heart of the walleye capitol of Canada, this Bay of Quinte kayak fishing tournament never disappoints. We have hosted May and July tournaments over the past 8 years with both months producing good numbers and a fantastic multispecies variety.

This year's tournament is moved back to the spring to take advantage of the larger migratory pike and walleye that tend to leave by summer. Some giant sheephead will surprise a few anglers too!

The large boundary allows anglers to easily target both species over two days of competition.

2 – TARGET SPECIES: Northern Pike & Walleye

- Tournament is May 25/26
- Paid Entry Fees—Admin Fees/Species Number = per Species Payout
- Cash Payout format is 75% of entry fees to Top 5 Pike and Walleye
- 2019 Provincial Championship Qualifier
- Top 10 per species qualify for Championship
- Highest combined length qualifies for OLD TOWN Topwater PDL drawn at Championship
- Prize structure is as follows: based on 40 anglers
 - 40 anglers x 85 Entry Fees = \$3400
 - 3400 – 25% Admin Fees = \$2550
 - 2550/2 Species = \$1275/Species
 - Top 5 of each species receives a portion of the Cash Pool
- Cost is \$85CDN for 2 days of both species
- Payout will be adjusted if based on attendance
- Registration deadline is April 1
