This is a unique season long tournament challenging Canadian and American kayak anglers to ply their skills on their Country's largest stage, the Great Lakes. A combined limit of Cold Water and Warm Water fish that will garner bragging rights as *Best Freshwater Kayak Angler in North America*.

This challenge will surely tap the highest potential of every angler!

12 – FISH SPECIES

5 Warm Water:

Catfish, Musky, Pike, Smallmouth Bass, Walleye

7 Cold Water:

Atlantic Salmon, Chinook Salmon, Coho Salmon, Pink Salmon, Brown Trout, Lake Trout, Steelhead

- Challenge runs from April 1 to Nov 30
- Payouts per longest of each species
- Paid Entry Fees – Admin Fees = per Species Payout
- SAMPLE Prize Structure is as follows:
 - Pike: \$25 x 30 anglers – 25% Admin Fees = \$562.50 single species payout
- Cost is \$25CDN per species
- You must identify your target species prior to submission
- Top 5 per species qualify for Provincial Championship = 60 chances to qualify
- Longest combined length qualifies for OLD TOWN Topwater PDL drawn at Championship
- Registration deadline is April 1
