



TOURNEY BRIEF: 2019 ONTARIO KAYAK FISHING CHAMPIONSHIP

Hosted for the second year in the Lake Couchiching and Lakes Simcoe area, the 2019 Ontario Kayak Fishing Championship will focus on Smallmouth Bass exclusively.

Last year's tournament experienced a cold front from the day prior, so we have extended this event to two days to allow for adjustment.

Lake Simcoe is highly regarded known as the land of giant Smallmouth Bass and the record heaviest tournament bag to date. Lake Couchiching included, there are some big fish expectations for this one!

TARGET SPECIES: Smallmouth Bass

- Tournament is September 7/8
- Headquarters TBA
- Paid Entry Fees—Admin Fees/Species Number = per Species Payout
- Cash Payout format is 80% of entry fees to Top 7 Smallmouth limits
- 2 Day Limit is six Smallmouth per angler
- 1st Place qualifies for OLD TOWN Topwater PDL drawn at Championship
- Prize structure is as follows: based on 40 anglers
 - 40 anglers x 125 Entry Fees = \$5000
 - 5000 – 20% Admin Fees = \$4000
 - Cash Payout 4000 – 50% 1st Place guarantee = \$2000 Cash Pool
 - 2nd-7th Place split remaining \$2000 Cash Pool
- Cost is \$125CDN for 2 days of both species
- Payout will be adjusted if based on attendance
- Registration deadline is September 1
- TourneyX Scoring System
- OKFS General Rules apply
